The City of Monterey Recreation and the Food Bank for Monterey County are pleased to offer a weekly produce distribution service for seniors on Mondays, excluding holidays. Please review the instructions to reserve your spot for the walk-up distribution program and pick up your produce. **RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED.** Produce will be distributed by appointment/reservation only every half hour beginning at 10:00am until 11:30am.

How to Sign-Up:

- **1.** Option 1 (recommended): Visit www.monterey.org/rec and click on the link on the top of the page to register for the program.
- 2. Option 2: Call Scholze Park Center at 831.646.3878 and reserve over the phone with a staff member or leave a message. Please note: If you leave a message, there will be a delay in registration and space could become unavailable.

Produce Distribution Pick-Up Instructions (Every Monday, excluding holidays)

- 1. <u>Please do not arrive early</u>. Your reservation guarantees your produce for you. All produce will be pre-packaged and the same for everyone. If traffic becomes an issue, the program could be cancelled.
- 2. Location is the <u>main entrance at Scholze Park Center</u>, 280 Dickman Avenue. Arrive at location and find parking on Lighthouse, Dickman or Foam Avenues.
- 3. This produce is walk-up and reservation only. There are no drive-thru pick up options available.
